CLU (1970s)

CLU extended ALGOL with data types that had code that operated on them; an important step in the development of object-oriented programming languages.

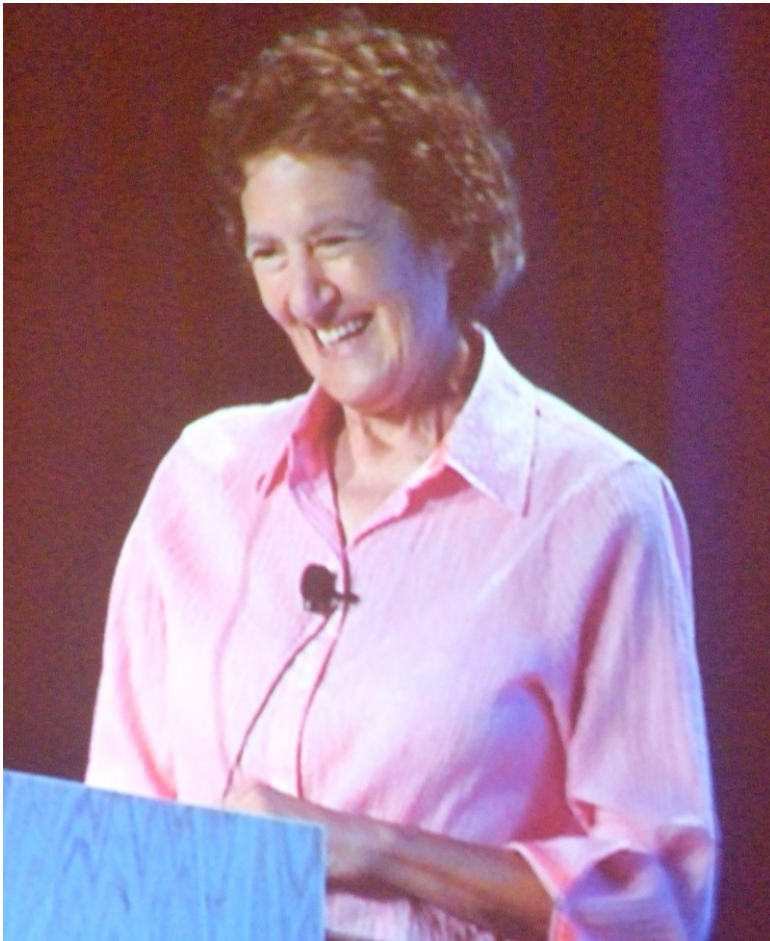
Argus (1980s)
